and have be-come my sal - va - tion. The stone which the build-ers re - ject -

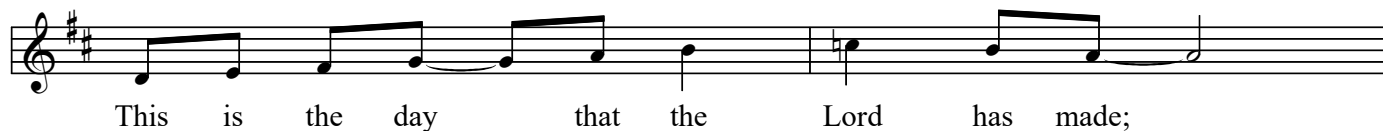


ed has be - come the chief cor - ner - stone.

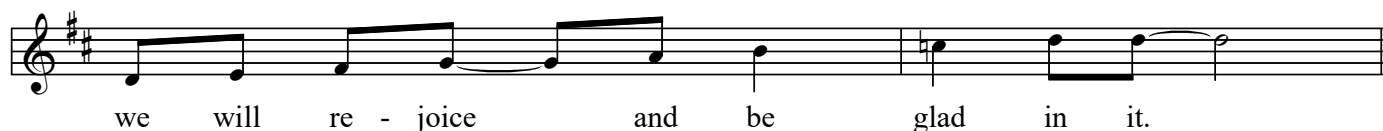
